# Important Information about Your Health Care Coverage

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**\*\* Please Read \*\***

Upcoming changes to Medicaid may impact people who receive long-term care services.

In order to receive Medicaid, your income must be below the Medicaid income limit set by the State. In 2016, the monthly income limit is \$2199.00.

Starting in July 2016, if your income is over the limit, you may deposit your excess income into a Qualified Income Trust which may allow you to stay eligible for Medicaid.

Our records indicate that you may need to set up a Qualified Income Trust. If you have questions about these changes, we can help you.

Ohio Medicaid has hired Automated Health Systems to reach out to you about your QIT and answer any questions you may have. If you need a trust, Automated Health Systems through its attorneys can also help you set it up at no cost to you. You do not have to use Automated Health Systems to set up the trust; instead, you may also use your own attorney.

You are encouraged to establish your Qualified Income Trust prior to July 1. If you do not establish a trust by July 1, you will need to do so prior to your next Medicaid redetermination date in order to maintain coverage.
