- Certificate of Completion was awarded to all participants from the second and third quarter.

Achievements:

- Sienna Nursing Facility: 46/58 participants /79% participation
- Villa Vista: 29/34 participants /85% participation
- Laurels: 25/30 participants /83% participation
- Altercare Adena: 24/24 participants /100% participation
- Country Club Manor: 58/62 participants /93% participation
