Subject: Medicaid: 2018 Standard Utility Allowance Increase

Reason for Change:

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, Office of Family Assistance, with approval from the federal Food and Nutrition Services (FNS), is increasing the Standard Utility Allowance (SUA) for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) from \$530 to \$544 effective October 1, 2018.

For Medicaid purposes, the SUA is used in the determination of the monthly income allowance (MIA) for the community spouse in long-term care (LTC) budgeting. Changes in the MIA amount may affect the patient liability amount for the LTC individual.

Action Required:

A mass change will run on all LTC cases that contain a community spouse prior to the last day of adverse action for September, making any adjustments in the patient liability amount effective October 1, 2018. A notice of action (NOA) will be generated advising of any changes. If there are no changes to the program block as a result of the mass change, a NOA will not be generated. A journal entry will be automatically entered when the mass change run was successful.

An alert or report will be provided if the LTC program block that contains a community spouse is excluded from the mass change batch. The assigned worker will need to run manual Eligibility Determination Budget Calculation (EDBC) on these cases, issue a NOA, and document with a journal entry.
