SUBJECT: Payment for Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) Furnished at a

Federally Qualified Health Center (FOHC) or Rural Health Clinic (RHC)

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) is providing this guidance to clarify when a provider may submit a claim for a long-acting reversible contraception (LARC) device or implant inserted at an FQHC or RHC.

In addition to submitting a claim for an FQHC or RHC medical visit for a LARC insertion procedure, separate payment may be made for a LARC device or implant. FQHCs and RHCs may submit claims to ODM for the LARC device or implant using their ambulatory health care clinic provider number (provider type 50). Payment amounts for covered LARC devices and implants are listed on the Provider-Administered Pharmaceuticals payment table at http://www.medicaid.ohio.gov [PROVIDERS > Fee Schedule and Rates > (I Agree)].

Additional Information

This MAL does not apply to a LARC device or implant inserted in a hospital setting.

The requirements set forth in Medicaid Advisory Letter (MAL) No.617 apply.
