

ODM 3rd Party Resource Day (3PRD)

Overview:

3PRD Days offer a venue for the third parties, (vendors, nonprofits, sister agencies, etc.) to present a high-level overview of their services, products, and/or resources to allow ODM staff to learn; what is available in the market, what other states are doing and market trends in a clear and open way in a structured environment.

Note: 3PRD does NOT replace the competitive procurement process or requirements.

Process

- 1- Third Parties complete the application submit it to the Office of Contracts and Procurement (OCP) 3PRD email box, 3rdpartyresourceday@medicaid.ohio.gov. The application may be submitted annually.
- 2- OCP will acknowledge receipt of the application and will apply the predetermined scoring criteria to determine value to the agency.
- 3- Application acceptance will close two weeks prior to the scheduled 3PRD.
- 4- The highest scoring entities will be invited to attend the next scheduled 3PRD.
- 5- OCP will contact the selected third parties to schedule presentations for the next scheduled 3PRD.
- 6- 3PRD will be held on-site at ODM, 50 W Town Street Columbus, OH 43215 approximately once every four (4) to six (6) weeks.
- 7- Virtual presentations will be allowed but require one on-site representative.
- 8- ODM will set the agenda for the day.
- 9- All third parties will be required to sign in with security.
- 10- ODM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to reject any application.
- 11- A third party may also submit a capability statement to supplement their application, of up to 2 pages in length.

Expectations for 3PRD

Third parties will be expected to follow the procedures and timelines put in place by ODM. All participants are expected to follow the Ohio ethics and conflict of interest laws. ODM will follow up with Third Parties as applicable.

Allowable topics:

- Company general capabilities;
- Services, products and resources available to support ODM;
- Questions by ODM staff to the third party regarding their products or services; and
- Any information regarding ODM business that is publicly available.

Topics that will not be discussed, include but are not limited to the following:

- Any ODM or state procurement being developed;
- Any information related to ODM that is not publicly available;
- Any ODM or state procurement currently open; and
- Questions about upcoming contract work Medicaid is seeking to procure.
